

The aim of Ljubljana Conference – University of Maribor, 22 – 23 September, 2011

Since few scientific conferences focus on criminal investigation and forensic science, there is a need for an exchange of views regarding:

- specialized detection and investigation on terrorism as well as organized transnational forms of crime;
- terminology, research, training as well as literature on criminal problems;
- modern techniques and methods of criminal investigation and evidence;
- legal problems regarding prosecution of criminals and human rights and individual freedom

The conference will take place in Slovenia – a country which is today a centre of criminalistics at a university level and a modern centre of criminal justice studies.

The major topics of the conference:

- Criminal investigation in different legal systems, differences between Eastern and Western Europe
- Modern research in criminal investigation and review on scientific literature
- Development of forensic sciences
- The future of criminal investigation

The participants of the conference are researchers, lecturers, judges, lawyers, prosecutors, police chiefs as well as post-graduate students specializing in criminal investigation.
